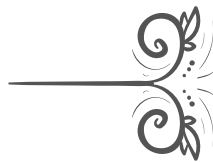


- Once you arrive, we will confirm that you are pre-registered with your credit card on file (via our [auction website](#)). We request you pre-register prior to our event however we will have the capability to register your credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover) on site, if necessary.

 - At your place setting, you will find your Bid Card along with a Catalog, if requested. We will also have one Catalog per table available for group viewing.
 - Please note for Food/Drink:
 - For those with dietary restrictions: Gluten Free and Vegetarian options will be clearly marked on a separate buffet table. If you selected a Vegetarian or Gluten Free option, please take your Meal Card at your place setting to the marked buffet with you to hand to the server. Gluten Free bread will be provided at your table.
 - Adult Beverages: 2 complimentary drink tickets per person will be provided. Additional drink tickets may be purchased for \$7 using your bid number. Volunteers selling drink tickets will be wearing a gold balloon.

SILENT AUCTION RULES

- Silent auction bidding will be completed on your mobile device. Therefore, no bid sheets on tables will be present as all transactions will be done online.
 - For bidding, silent auction tables will have package specific QR codes to scan on the tables. Alternatively, you can use our auction website: anightatthederby.ggo.bid and search for packages by name or number by using the magnifying glass or by choosing a category under the menu. To get back to the main screen, click the house icon.
 - You can Bid the next increment or Bid More than the next increment. If you choose Bid More you can set your max bid. If your max bid is the highest, the system will automatically bid in your favor until you are outbid or until the auction closes.
 - To “watch” a package, select the star icon on the package.
 - You'll be notified if you're outbid at any point before the auction closes and you will see an Outbid notice at the top of your screen.
 - To view the packages you are bidding on, click the menu button and select Bids.
 - To make a basic donation, simply click on the “Make a difference by making a donation” button.
 - Multiple Sales Items: A few items may have a limited number of spots available (Ex: Teacher Experiences). Once these spots have been sold, you will no longer be able to bid on this item.

LIVE AUCTION RULES

- To bid on an item, raise your bid number until the auctioneer acknowledges it. You are the successful bidder when the auctioneer says, "SOLD" and acknowledges your bid number. In the event of any dispute between bidders, the auctioneer has final discretion.

PE & Play

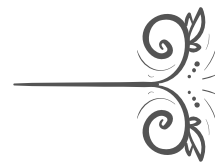

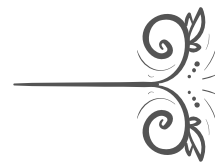
Art Docent Program
